Project: Math About Me

Math is a BIG part of who you are! Set off on a “math hunt” to discover how numbers are part of who you are. Choose at least 5 important numbers in your life to use for this project.

- Step 1: Complete the planning page by going on a “math hunt” (See the list of ideas to guide you)
- Step:2 Use “Pic Collage” to record your findings.
Set up a new page on Pic Collage.
Take a picture of yourself and place it in the middle of your collage. Insert a title “Math about (insert your name here). Then add the date underneath your photo.
- Step 3 Either use photos from your camera roll or the “use camera” option to insert your photo math examples into your collage.
- Step 4: Under each picture, write a caption to describe how your photo is related to a number about you. You do this by pressing on the “+” button on the bottom and then press “add text”.
- Step 5: Change the background to enhance your collage. You can even add stickers to add to the beauty of your project.
- Step 6: Save it to your library and be prepared to share your collage.

Here is a list of ideas:

Your age in years, months, days, hours, or even minutes!

The number of people in your family

Your street address

The number of letters in your name

Your height or the total height of everyone in your family

Your zip code

The number of items in your collection (example: I have 213 stuffed animals)

The number of pairs of shoes you own

The perimeter of your bedroom

How many hours of sleep you get each night
